Provides help with such things as utilities or a laptop



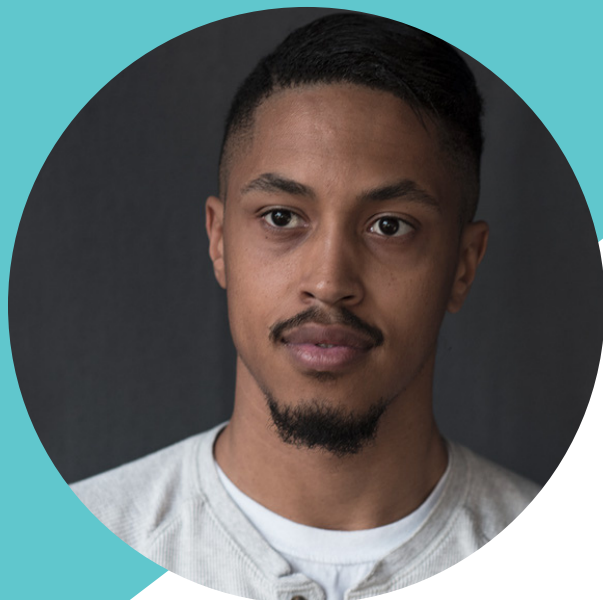
Friend: Create a Welcome Home Box
