Why Volunteer?



Whether mentoring, speaking, or conducting mock interviews, your time directly empowers people to break cycles of incarceration, secure employment, and create lasting change in their communities.

Requirements

- Fill out the Volunteer Application.
- Attend an onboarding call with a member of Persevere's volunteer team.
- Finalize role preferences.
- Fill out onboarding paperwork.
- Tech Mentors are matched and begin meeting weekly with a graduate.
- All other roles monitor Guest Speaker/Mock Interviewer requests via email.

Guest Speakers

Virtual Guest Speakers inspire and educate our participants by sharing real-world insights from the tech industry and beyond. Speakers present on topics like their career journey, industry trends, overcoming challenges, or community resources, which helps our students build confidence and envision their own path forward.

Mock Interviewers

Mock Interviewers help Persevere students gain confidence and experience by simulating real-world tech job interviews. We conduct both soft skills and technical interviews, so whether you have experience in HR, hiring, or tech, your expertise can make a lasting impact. By volunteering your time and industry knowledge, you'll help prepare justice-impacted individuals for success in their job search and long-term tech careers.

Working / with graduates

Tech Mentors

Tech Mentors provide one-on-one guidance to aspiring developers who have completed our core training program. Upon request from a participant post-release, mentors are matched based on their technical expertise and availability. Mentors bring their own strengths to the relationship, whether it's introducing new programming languages like Python, assisting with portfolio tools like GitHub and LinkedIn, or guiding mentees through real-world coding challenges.
